You are scheduled to be available at your poster for 1½ hours, beginning at 9:30 AM. Show this letter to Security at the Poster check-in desk, to access the poster area between 7:30 a.m. and opening time. Posters must be removed by 5:00 a.m. Saturday through Monday, and 12:00 noon on Tuesday. Please check bags, convention materials, poster tubes, etc. in the Poster Storage area.

Commercial Logos: Commercial logos must NOT be placed on posters or poster boards. Be sure to communicate this if the poster is being prepared for you by someone else.

Embargo: Please be advised that it is ASM's policy that, while presenters are allowed to communicate with the press, their discussions may not be published until after the day and time of the actual presentation.

Penalties: By submitting your abstract, you have agreed that you would present it at ICAAC. If unable to make your presentation, you should have notified ASM by May 31. Please note that you risk not being allowed to present at future ASM meetings, for a period of three years, if you 1) fail to present an accepted abstract, 2) present previously published data, or 3) your presentation is promotional in nature.
